4.7 The Humphry Davy Quarter: Create a focus for retail, culture, food and drink at the heart of the Town Centre around a community use for The Market House. To include traffic calming and increased pedestrian priority.							
4.8 Floating Harbour: Work with CC to re-organise the landside of the harbour to create open views and public access from Wharf Road whilst enhancing the economic value delivered by harbour activities and supporting landside business.							
4.9 Jubilee Pool and Promenade: Re-invigorate the Pool through additional uses and longer season to increase economic potential of the Asset. Improve public access to and from pool and promenade and Headland Destination.							
4.10 Promenade / Esplanade: Increase the potential for year round activities on the promenade and concentration of events during the Spring – Summer seasons. Incorporate open Gym with free access training equipment etc.

Build on the success of the Skatepark to generate an urban/adventure sports centre. Develop mixed use, public access scheme for former Jewson's site, connected into the Rugby Ground.							
4.12 Newlyn Green: Improve facilities for all on Newlyn Green and create a user friendly link between Penzance and Newlyn (lighting, seating etc). Extension of Promenade as part of Mounts Bay Maritime Park (MBMP) concept.							
4.13 Heart of Newlyn: Build on the artistic heritage and thriving artistic creative industries in Newlyn to develop a "creative hub" for creative industries. Enhance visual and physical connectivity between urban core and harbour-side as part of MBMP.							
4.14 Sandy Cove: Focus for maritime engineering to service maritime industries across whole of Mount's Bay. To incorporate public route as part of MBMP.							
4.15 Port Penlee: Open up disused quarry to create a marina and hotel complex. Potential use of rock for construction of breakwater currently under consideration.							
4.16 Mount's Bay Breakwater: Essential infrastructure to ensure protection of the exposed coastline of Mount's Bay. Regenerative spin-offs
